ANSI-CAP

- Stands for Certificate Accreditation Program
- Accredited programs are in compliance with ASTM E2659-09 Standard Practice for Certificate Programs
- ASTM 2659-090 is ANSI's preferred international standard for accreditation

Certificate v. Certification

- Certificate - a document awarded to certificate holders that designates the successful completion of a certificate program's requisites. (learning and coursework completion)
- Certification - Defines competencies, skills and personal attributes. Examination must be independent and a valid test of competence. (pertaining to a specific body of knowledge/profession)

ManageMen, Inc.

- Just completed first training course under these new guidelines to satisfy preliminary accreditation requirements.
- Controlled Documents from this course will be used for accreditation process.
- Goal: ManageMen to be an ANSI Accredited Certificate issuer for Certificate Holders of OSI Training (CHOT)

ManageMen, Inc.

- Our goal is to issue certificates as from a program that has been accredited by ANSI
- Organizations with Certificate Holders of (OSI) Training (CHOT) will be entitled to become (OSI) affiliates.
- (OSI) affiliates are entitled to train on the (OSI) process independent of ManageMen.

Benefits

- Separates organizations with CHOTs from copy cat organizations
- Entitles organizations with CHOTs to become (OSI) Affiliates
- (OSI) Affiliates are entitled to teach (OSI) principles without involving ManageMen as a method of spreading the (OSI) program
